

ACCESS TO SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

In so far as it is practical, Radio Maria Ireland strives to make its building and services accessible to people with disabilities. While not a public body – and thus not strictly required to comply with sections 26 to 28 of the *Disabilities Act 2005* – Radio Maria Ireland has made extensive efforts to ensure that its building and services provide access to people with disabilities, where practical and appropriate.

Radio Maria Ireland's services include radio (currently available online and via smartphone apps, with applications to the Broadcasting Authority of Ireland pending in relation to DAB, cable and satellite services); its website Radiomaria.ie, social media sites, and publications (including its monthly newsletter).

Daily contact with Radio Maria Ireland is made available to the deaf and hard of hearing through Radiomaria.ie, its social media sites, a special SMS text-messaging service (SMS: 085 11 77 030) and email address (info@radiomaria.ie).

People in wheelchairs who visit the Radio Maria Ireland studios at St Anthony's Business Park, Ballymount Road, Dublin 22, will find that all studios have wheelchair access, as have all public areas and offices.
